Quantum Computing

**Professor Christian Arenz** School of Electrical, Computer and **Energy Engineering, ASU** 



Professor Arenz joined Arizona State University as an assistant professor in the School of Electrical, Computer and Energy Engineering in January 2022. Prior to joining ASU he was a lecturer and an associate research scholar at Princeton University. Previously, he completed his PhD in applied mathematics at Aberystwyth University in 2016, where he focused

on the control of open and noisy quantum systems.

Abstract: Professor Arenz will discuss the history of quantum computing and how it differs fundamentally from the standard or digital computer. He will discuss how quantum computing offers the possibility of solving problems that can't reasonably be solved by a standard computer and its application to current research areas such as artificial intelligence."

Derek Cridebring, Ph.D. Director of the Molecular Medicine Division TGen



Derek Cridebring, Ph.D. is currently Director of the Molecular Medicine Division at the Translational Genomics Research Institute (TGen) in Phoenix, Arizona. He was born and raised in Phoenix and earned his B.S. in Biochemistry at the University of Arizona in Tucson. During his time at the U of AZ he joined the Army Reserves and earned the distinction of Soldier of the Year of the 7220th Reserve Unit. After finishing his bachelor's degree, Dr.Cridebring attended Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, TX, obtaining his Ph.D. -Neuroscience and Biochemistry, for his work on the neurodegenerative disease (ALS). Also, during his time in graduate school, his reserve unit was called to duty and he served a year in Iraq as a Preventive Medicine Specialist during Operation Iraqi Freedom.
