Eligibility Requirements:

- AZ resident and US citizen*
- **STEM**-bound candidate who will have completed two full years of STEM credits by Spring 2025 and **preparing to attend the university Fall 2025.**
- All credits must be transferable to any Arizona university.
- Applicant must provide evidence of acceptance to a STEM program at an Arizona four-year degree university.
- Must have a **3.0 GPA** and demonstrate financial need.
- Submit unofficial academic transcripts.
- All Science, Technology, Engineering or Math students who are eligible should apply. Preference will be given to students who are graduates of Dysart, Glendale, Peoria, Deer Valley, Agua Fria, Nadaburg, Buckeye, Tolleson Unified School Districts, or Paradise Honors High School.
- **Two recommendation letters** from individuals professionally competent to make informed judgments of applicant's success through a 4-year Science, Technology, Engineering or Math Baccalaureate.
